5. Articles should be one-half (1.5)-spaced on A4 paper dimensions, using a 12-point font size and a default typeface (recommended fonts are Tahoma, Times New Roman, Helvetica, Calibri and Arial). The article should not exceed 30 pages or 10,000 words. References, footnotes, and legends should be single-spaced.
 6. Text should be cited using Harvard referencing style listed alphabetically at the end of the article.
 7. Articles must present the highest intellectual integrity to be authenticated by the 'turn-it-in' anti-piracy software. High premium is placed on originality and adequate standards of data, techniques, methodology, and result reporting. We seek to protect the rights of our authors and we always investigate claims of plagiarism or misuse of published articles. Equally, we seek to protect the reputation of the journal against malpractice.
